Recreation Reimbursement Policy

This fund was established to assist families and encourage the healthy, active lifestyle and promote growth in recreational activities to the children of Nipissing First Nation.

Recreation reimbursement will be granted for a maximum of 50% of the registration cost up to \$200/year (April 1 – March 31) for each child who is a band member, residing on reserve.

Requests for assistance must include the original receipt outlining the cost for the activity, and submitted to the Recreation program. All requests will be considered using the following criteria:

1. The request must be sent to the recreation department.
2. Receipt must indicate the child's name, business/sport organization type, and amount paid for that child (amount per child must be indicated if combined on one receipt).
3. Child must reside on Nipissing First Nation to be funded (identifying residency: Child must reside on NFN for six months of the fiscal year of reimbursement).
4. To be eligible the child's age must be 18 years of age or younger.
5. Approval will be granted for the registration of children to join organized teams, group or recreational activities.
6. Parents must first pay the registration fee and then bring the fully paid receipt to the band office for reimbursement of 50% (up to \$200).

In the event of an exceptional request, the request will be brought to the Recreation Committee for review
