



Natural Resources Fisheries Technician

2 Full Time Contract Positions (25 weeks)

Nipissing First Nation's Natural Resources Department is seeking two (2) Fisheries Technicians to be responsible for supporting the Biologist. Technicians will be responsible for the collection and management of research data such as species, age, weight, length and scale samples for analysis. Other responsibilities will include administrative tasks such as the creation and maintenance of records and equipment. Anticipated start date is in May 2019.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a registered Nipissing First Nation member.
- Must have experience in a related field.
- A graduate in Fisheries and Wildlife will be considered a definite asset.
- Must have experience with safely operating boats, motors and have knowledge of Lake Nipissing.
- Must have a valid class "G" driver's license; a Pleasure Craft Operators Card considered an asset.

REQUIRED SKILLS:

- Keen interest in natural resources management and dedication to conservation principles.
- Ability to demonstrate knowledge of Nipissing First Nation Fisheries Laws and Regulations and current issues.
- Ability to work in inclement weather and harsh conditions and to perform shift work.
- Must be able to stand, walk, sit, climb or balance, stoop, kneel or crouch; regularly lift and/or move up to 10 pounds; frequently lift and/or move up to 25 pounds; and occasionally lift and/or move up to 50 pounds.
- Strong organizational and interpersonal skills; experience using Microsoft Office applications.

DUTIES:

- Reports directly to the Natural Resources Manager.
- Assists Biologist with assessment projects, including but not limited to: cleaning and maintaining equipment, collecting samples and specimens.
- Operates large and small vessels and other equipment.
- Assists with shoreline assessments.
- Follows all policies, procedures and practices within the Natural Resources Department.
- Attends meetings of Council and Committees, as required by the Natural Resources Manager.
- Performs other related duties as may be reasonably required by the Natural Resources Manager.

A current Criminal Reference check is required for all new Nipissing First Nation employees.
