Stewardship Youth Rangers (4)

As a Stewardship Youth Ranger, you will work as part of a team of 4 rangers under the direction of one Team Lead and the Nipissing First Nation Employment & Training Manager. Rangers work on natural resource management projects in their own communities and meet daily at a central location. Most projects will be outdoors and could involve rough terrain and a variety of weather conditions.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- Must be a registered member of Nipissing First Nation
- Must be a student born in 2002. Applicants may be 16 or 17 at the time of hire, but not turning 18 before December 31, 2019.
- Must be a resident of Ontario and able to work in Canada.

TEAM SKILLS:

- You have demonstrated the ability to build and maintain effective relationships working in a team (i.e. at work, in school, in other personal activities) to achieve common goals.
- You have personal leadership skills (i.e. organizational skills, responsibility) to initiate and complete tasks in timely manner.
- You have oral communication skills to speak with co-workers, supervisors, and community members.
