



COMMITTEE MEMBERSHIP SELECTION

1. To serve on Council Advisory committees, applicants must be registered members of Nipissing First Nation.
2. Where there are more applications than the maximum allowable membership on a committee, first priority will be given to community members who are **not** employed by NFN administration, and the second priority being employees of Nipissing First Nation.
3. To eliminate possible conflicts in the workplace, employees will only be allowed to participate on committees if the committee has no direct or indirect association with their position. The Chief Executive Officer shall have the discretion to determine when the workplace has been negatively affected due to an employee's role on a committee.
4. In the event that a committee member becomes an employee or contractor of Nipissing First Nation, either by short term contract, part-time, casual or full time employment, the individual may be asked to resign their committee seat, depending on the accepted position and relationship to the committee, at the discretion of the Chief Executive Officer.
