on River.



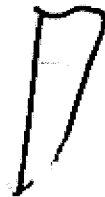
