

SENIOR'S GRASS CUTTING POLICY

PURPOSE:

Nipissing First Nation provides grass cutting services only to seniors of Nipissing First Nation.

- 1. Seniors must meet the following criteria in order to be eligible to qualify for services under this policy:
 - (a) Must be an NFN registered member 65 years of age or over.
 - (b) The senior requesting the service is the primary owner or primary tenant. The residence must be their principal (primary) residence.
 - (c) The home must be situated on Nipissing First Nation land and within the area being serviced by the Public Works department.
 - (d) Requests must be made to the Facilities Department.
 - (e) Service will commence mid-May and end October 1st of each year.
- 2. Seniors who meet the above criteria will be advised of the following:
 - (a) It is the responsibility of the home owner or primary tenant to ensure that their property is clear of any large obstacles or debris.
 - (b) The number of cuts undertaken and schedule varies according to the type of area to be cut, and will also depend on the prevailing weather conditions. Continued bad weather can delay cutting and extended dry weather may make cutting unnecessary.
 - (c) The Seniors Grass Cutting program is strictly intended for grass cutting services, and will not be extended to other property services.
 - (d) Primary home owner or primary tenant must sign a "Waiver of Liability" prior to receiving services.
