Notice of Appointment of Mediator:

Notice of Appointment for mediation shall be delivered to both spouses by the Chief and Council no later than 10 days before the date of the appointment, and a copy of the Notice shall be delivered to the Lands Manager.

Duty to Attend:

A spouse who receives a Notice of Appointment with a mediator has a duty to attend the mediation.

Payment of Costs:

Each spouse is obliged to pay his or her equal share of the costs of mediation.

Requirements for Service:

Service may be affected by personal service, by delivery to a solicitor representing the other spouse in the matter of the breakdown of the marriage, as provided in a domestic contract, or by registered mail to the address where each spouse is known or believed to be residing. Service by registered mail shall be deemed to be effected four days after the day the notice is mailed. By advertisement in the local newspaper of last location of residence.

Proof of Service:
