Lunch Time:

The designated lunch time for those children who are going home for lunch is 12:00 – 1:00pm. Children within the program will not be permitted to leave the program at any other time (store or to leave with anyone not on the pick-up list).

Attendance & Notifying Staff

If you have changes to pick up information, please inform one of the lead staff (listed above). We also ask that if your child is not attending for the day, that you notify a lead staff member.

Trips

We hope that your child will enjoy the program that we have planned for the Summer Children's Program. We have attempted to provide balance and offering a variety of activities for everyone to enjoy or to try something new. We have also attempted to plan for a fun outing or trip once per week. By spreading this out, we offer something for every child who is enrolled on a weekly basis.

For the trips, we ask that you not send money or send at your own risk. The staff of the program and the program will not be responsible for lost or misplaced money or items.

Permission forms will be sent home with your child and must be returned in order for them to participate. Forms will also be posted on the Facebook group. Parents will be given that link or information, if they are already not on the page, if they wish to join. It proved to be a useful tool for keeping families and staff informed.

Rules:

We are asking parents to review these rules with your children and support them for the enjoyment of all participants.

- No electronics allowed (Tablets, Cell Phones, MP3 Players, Game Systems)
- Listen and Follow all instructions
- Keep hands, feet and objects to yourself
- No bad language (swearing or teasing)
- No Bullying – Be kind and respectful to one another
- Ask/inform staff when going to the washroom
- Clean up after yourself & equipment
- Respect the equipment (don't break or misuse)
