The successful candidate will ensure communications and reporting are shared with the community and Council as required throughout the project. (Number of hours to be determined, up to 24 hours per week).

**Project Details:** McIntosh Perry has been retained by the Ministry of Transportation to carry out the detailed design and Class Environmental Assessment for the rehabilitation of Highway 17 from 0.1 km west of Laronde Creek Bridge easterly to 0.3 km west of Gormanville Road for 18.0 km and the replacement of:

- Laronde Creek Bridge 16.1 km west of Hwy 17B (Main St); and
- Little Cache Creek Culvert 5.6 km west of East Junction Hwy 64
