### Shuttle Service Drivers

Contract Position: April 26, 2021 to July 30, 2021

Under the direction and supervision of the Employment & Training Manager or designate, Nipissing First Nation is seeking drivers to provide shuttle services during the Highway 17B Duchesnay Creek bridge replacement project.

Specific responsibilities include shift work availability, driving the assigned transit route (via Hwy 17 and down Gormanville to Main Street to Oak Street Bus Terminal and return), picking up and dropping off patrons, assisting patrons, and ensuring safe and orderly conduct upon boarding and leaving the van, and during transport.

**Hours:** Shift work, maximum 35 hours per week

Coverage – 7 days a week, 6 a.m. to 12 midnight (including weekends and holidays)

**Rate of Pay:** \$19.00 per hour

#### QUALIFICATIONS

- Must be a registered Nipissing First Nation member.
- Must have a valid Ontario Driver's licence and clean drivers abstract.
- Must be professional in appearance, vocabulary, and dealing with clients.
- Ability to read, write and knowledgeable of surrounding areas.
- Must be 21 years or older.

#### DUTIES

- Dedicated driving responsibility, maintaining timely schedule of transit route.
- Provide trip logs and requested documentation to Employment & Training manager or designate.
- Ensure riders use the seatbelts provided.
- Must have ability to stay calm during an emergency.
- Other duties as required.
